Cryptocurrency wallets from Dash have a critical ''malware' file detected only with BitDefender. This is a false positive. I have made exclusions for the detection but still BitDefender cleverly manages to block it one way or another every time.

Please run a scan on this image file:

I am not the only one continuing to have the same problem, and only with BitDefender it seems. I reinstall the wallet again every time the file is detected and deleted, rendering the program useless. Please test this program for unwarranted red flags and contact the developers at Dash if necessary for technical assistance.

This issue appeared to be resolved.. although as of today I am having the same problem with a false positive as I was experiencing 3 weeks ago which was previously reported.

My antivirus is auto-updated regularly and it seemed to have only come back today with a recent update.

We are sorry for the first misunderstanding.

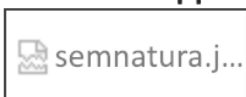
